

# LUMIÈRE CAPSULE COLLECTION

**Textile architectures merge with light,  
enhancing the MAXIMO modular sofa**

**FuoriSalone 2026 | Nardi Showroom Milano, Via Pontaccio 19**

New textures for outdoor living with **Lumière**, the brand-new capsule collection of upholstered elements that completely revamp the MAXIMO modular sofa with its regenerated resin frame.

Precious weaves, exclusive patterns and sophisticated colours adorn the seating system with stunning appeal. MAXIMO retains its signature design, featuring unique details and quality, yet sports an innovative look, revealing its exceptional versatility.

The capsule collection, comprising two designs, *Brise Soleil* and *Modulaire*, designed by Studio Pisk and developed in close collaboration with Celeste Italia, will be previewed at FuoriSalone 2026, at the Nardi Showroom Milano. These two fabrics are designed to interact with each other, taking on different roles as part of the MAXIMO system while balancing structure with decor, comfort with visual identity.

At the core of the design is *Modulaire*, the fabric that covers the seat and back cushions of MAXIMO, without sacrificing bold aesthetic appeal. The design evokes the façades of buildings designed by Gio Ponti, where modular repetition and geometric composition shape the architectural character. The pattern reflects the concept of neatness, continuity and structure, interpreting Ponti's style with a contemporary textile surface.

*Brise Soleil*, on the other hand, is the design chosen for the decor scatter cushions, decorative elements that enhance the overall effect with a recognisable and elegant touch. Inspired by the cement sunshades of Modernist architecture, the fabric represents the concept of screening light with dynamic, geometric and rhythmic graphics. Like sunshades, the design creates an interplay of solids and voids, shadows and overlaps, lending movement and visual depth to the sofa.

During Milano Design Week, the Nardi space will be exclusively showcasing the Lumière capsule collection in all the colour variations of the MAXIMO frame, in an evocative setting designed to fully enhance its unique features.

With the Lumière capsule collection, Nardi continues its path of research, enriched by new partnerships that give rise to original and iconic outdoor furniture solutions. The outcome is a harmonious balance of consistency and functionality. In this textile design project, the fabric becomes the ideal intersection between design, materials and the product, meeting the needs of contemporary outdoor living while providing striking stylistic identity.

## MAXIMO

Designed by Raffaello Galiotto and launched in 2024, MAXIMO – the modular sofa featuring a regenerated resin frame which, starting with the single armchair module, allows you to easily and quickly create countless layouts – immediately became one of Nardi's best-selling products. Its clean, balanced lines extend horizontally, conveying a sense of depth and length. The recycled resin frame is solid and strong but made aesthetically light by its modular triangular sections and rounded details.

It features large volumes, a deep and comfortable seat, and flexible and harmonious modularity thanks to the back and armrest fixing system. Complementing the collection is an attachable accessory module and a set of freestanding tables with a round top (MAXIMO Tavolino 70 and MAXIMO Tavolino 60 both available in two sizes: Mini and Maxi), as well as a version that can be integrated with the sofa frame (MAXIMO Tavolino 33) to meet all project requirements.
