IKSEL Corner @Nobilis - Largo Treves 5, Milano

This year, IKSEL presents its Scenic Decors in a selection of venues across the city of Milan and at Salone del Mobile in Rho Fiera.

At the **IKSEL Corner @ Nobilis** (Largo Treves 5), we are introducing *Pearl River*, a poetic panorama of 18th-Century Canton and its river. Hand-painted in our studio, this Decor is complemented by ceilings, wainscoting, and borders to serve as a complete setting. Come discover it alongside the rest of our 2026 collection.

Just across the street, at **Argenteria Dabbene** (Largo Treves 2), you can see our new *Patinir Landscape* Scenic Decor, unfolding across the full length of the five windows of this iconic *Bottega Storica*. This decor captures the naturalist sensibility of the Flemish Renaissance and the particular skies that characterize the work of the painter Joachim Patinir. Inside the shop, we are present with the exotic landscape *D-Dream*.

The link between the new Chinoiserie and the deep blue of Patinir Landscape can be found in the showroom of **Roberto Molteni** (Via Durini 3). Here, the interior designer selected the Chinoiserie *Eastern Eden* in the Turquoise colorway to decorate the ground floor of this impressive six-story showroom, occupying 1,250 sqm of a Milanese palazzo dedicated to the finest contemporary design.

At the new offices of **Studio 13.1** (Via Borgonuovo 5), Iksel was chosen to fully decorate the room set aside for project discussions. To create an atmosphere that combines elegance and privacy, the *Directoire Curtain* design was selected.

In the city centre we are also present with two new decors in collaboration with two of our longtime partners. The first is **Verdeolivia** (Via P. della Francesca 15) showcasing a custom version of the Scenic Decor *Aleppo Blue*. Mixing Persian and Ottoman inspirations, this decor exudes comfort and abundance. We then continue at **NAP Atelier** (Via della Braidà 1) whose walls are graced by the soft light of *Livia's Garden* in the pink Sunset colorway. You can also find our Decors at **La Casa di Babette**, **Bonati & Beneggi** and **Lo Studio**.

At Salone del Mobile in Rho Fiera, we are pleased to announce our collaboration with **Maison Numéro 20**. The French designer **Oscar Ono** selected Iksel for Project AUREA, involving fabrics and wallpaper to adorn the walls and ceilings of the main pavilion of the hospitality area. For this ambitious project, Iksel was selected for its aesthetic qualities and technical expertise, with the aim of decorating five different rooms. For the smoking parlour, the choice fell on two decors launched at this year's Paris Déco Off. On the walls: *Deco Forest*, originally designed for the smoking room of a Parisian apartment. This geometric Scenic Decor of palm trees captures the glamorous aura of the 1930s. On the ceiling, the assorted *Celestial Orbs Ceiling*, custom-made on fabric. In the Living Room, a variation of Celestial Orbs decorates the ceiling. The Bedroom Ceiling features *Granada Circles*, while the Dining Room showcases *Moody Mountain Ceiling*, custom-made on fabric. At the heart of the booth, the Winter Garden features a variation of Moody Mountains Ceiling, as appearing also in the Bathroom, assorted to *Moody Mountains* Scenic Decor on the walls.

We are also pleased to announce our collaboration with **Salda Arredamenti** for Salone del Mobile 2026, following our joint project in 2024. This year their booth will present a trilogy of Chinoiseries: *Chinese Suite*, *Exotic Chinoiserie*, and *Eastern Eden* in the new Alabaster colorway.

The History of Iksel

Mehmet & Dimonah Iksel founded Iksel Decorative Arts in 1988; the London based couple spent many years in India creating and running a studio which, still today, hand-paints their own designs for interior decoration. Their inspiration comes mostly from a pre-industrial world which produced high periods of style in the decorative arts. Encompassing many cultures and periods, their collections include architectural, botanical, ornamental and panoramic wallpapers.

The Iksels were the first in the design industry to recognize the exciting potential of the digital revolution. In 2001 they digitalized their vast archives of hand-painted panels and decors and became the inventors of a new art form which derives the highest resolution printing from decorative painting. Combining practicality with ultimate luxury, they have transformed wallpaper into custom frescoes. Their work is easily recognizable by its elaborate painting and finely textured backgrounds. Both technically and artistically, Iksel delivers the most sophisticated wallcoverings on the market.

Our Collections

Scenic Decors – All our signature Scenic wallpapers: landscapes, tented rooms, chi-noiseries; and many more. 71 Scenic Decors, available in 5 standard heights and a range of standard color options, resulting in over 18,000 different panels. What sets our Decors apart is the unique patina effect. Most of our wallpapers begin as a hand-painted work of art in our Painting Studio. Here, it is meticulously painted on a canvas primed with special gesso. As the gesso dries, it naturally cracks, creating an organic patina effect which is the hallmark of Iksel wallpapers.

Repeat Design Wallpapers - Encompassing 10 collections that traverse various ages and cultures across the globe. From the 10th century to the Art Deco era, our designs draw inspiration from diverse regions, including India, the Middle East, and Europe. Within this extensive selection of Repeat Designs, you will discover over a hundred patterns. Remarkably, over half of these Decors include their assorted fabric, allowing harmonious ensembles.

Ceilings - Assorted to our Scenic and Repeat Design Wallpapers, as well as Architectural Decors.

Furnishing Fabrics – A collection of designs assorted to our Repeat Design Wallpapers and Scenic Decors.

Architectural and Ornamental Decors - This is one of the specialities of Iksel's craftsmanship, Architectural designs fitted exactly to your projects, available in Custom only.

Decorative Panels - Panels that can be framed if on paper or stretched on frames if on canvas. To be used as a series, paired or as a single panel.

Archive Collection - Re-editions of rare antique wallpapers digitally restored by Iksel. These wallpapers are inspired by authentic designs that have adorned historical buildings for centuries. Often, these original wallpapers were cut to fit into intricate moldings. Our painstaking digital restoration work transforms these fragments into complete Decors. Once hung on walls, they exude an ageless charm, as if they have graced these spaces since forever.

Custom, Standard & More

Our Wallcoverings can be printed on 5 different media: our Standard Non Woven, Scrubbable Non Woven, Textile Coated Wallpaper and Glass Fibre Tex and Glass Fibre Smooth Wallpaper. The 5 media are Fire retardant, and 2 of them have additional qualities. Our Textile Coated Wallpaper & Glass Fibres offer an excellent color fastness to light and are extra scrubbable, to be used in areas like kitchens and bathrooms. Our Glass Fibre Wallpapers can even be used in wet areas, such as spas, and is offered in two different qualities: Glass Fibre Tex, woven with a light canvas texture, and Glass Fibre Smooth, non-woven with a paper touch. To use our Decors as Decorative Panels we offer the possibility to print on Cotton Canvas, to be stretched onto a frame. Our Decors are all available in custom sizes and colors with most of the collection available as Standard, with preselected sizes and colorways. Our latest addition is the Standard+ service, which allows you to create additional standard sizes for some Scenic and all Repeat Design Wallpapers. This service also allows you to select the background color from a rich color palette.
